1 Introduction

The American Heart Association (AHA) is dedicated to saving more lives through research, training, and education designed and owned by the AHA. CPRverify is a web-based application designed specifically to support AHA training internationally. The Instructor Network serves the same purpose within the United States.

These applications make it possible for Training Centers and instructors to monitor and track their AHA training, including publishing classes for students to sign up for, managing student rosters, and many other functions. They also provide the ability for managing Training Center alignments and permission.

Currently, the 2 applications are separate to cater to different geographies, either within USA or outside of USA. Atlas is a reimagined solution that caters to the global market. This digital platform is available to the AHA Training Network, including Training Centers, Sites, Instructors, and students who are located anywhere in the world, working together to make a difference and save more lives.

2 Purpose

The purpose of Atlas is to provide a single application for all audiences across the world. This document has been created to help ensure a smooth onboarding journey, focusing on the different capabilities within the Atlas application, and will serve as an instructional guide for users to successfully navigate and perform various application functions within the system.

5 My Alignments

5.1 Instructor Login




Figure 1. Instructor login.

- Log in as an **Instructor**, as shown in Figure 1.




Figure 2. Instructor Dashboard: Tasks to Complete section.

- To view pending alignment requests and role assignment notifications, refer to the **Tasks to Complete** section on the **Dashboard** (Figure 2).




Figure 3. Instructor Account: profile drop-down menu showing My Alignments option.

- For additional information, the user may select **My Alignments** from the profile drop-down menu to access all alignment information, including **Pending Request** and **Existing Alignment** (Figure 3).




Figure 4. Instructor Account: Training Center drop-down menu showing My Alignments option.

- As a navigation alternative to the one shown in Figure 4, the user may select **Training Center** from the main navigation menu and then **My Alignments** from the drop-down menu for the same result.

- The **Alignment** page displays all of the user's alignment information, including **Pending Request** and **Existing Alignment**. Also displayed are the associated Training Centers and Training Sites for each alignment (Figure 5).

5.1.1 Request Alignment




Figure 6. Instructor Account: Instructor Dashboard showing the Training Center Search link.

- To request alignment, the user may select the **Training Center Search** link under the **Quick Links** menu from the Instructor Dashboard (Figure 6).

- Alternatively, the user may select the **Find Training Centers** link on the **Alignment** page (Figure 7).

- The user will be navigated to the Training Center/Training Site Search Result page.




Figure 8. Training Center List: Training Center/Training Site Search Result.

- The user may then use the **Search by the TC/TS Name** text box to type in the name of Training Center they are trying to find and select the **Search** button (Figure 8).




Figure 11. Request Alignment button.

- Once the user finds the Training Center they were searching for, they may select the **Request Alignment** button (Figure 11).

- Once **Request Alignment** has been selected, a pop-up will appear. The number of available disciplines that the Training Center or Training Site has available for alignment will determine the type of pop-up that the user will see.




Figure 12. Request Alignment pop-up showing multiple disciplines available.

- For those Training Centers or Training Sites with multiple disciplines available for alignment, the user will be prompted to select the **discipline** for which they are requesting an alignment for (from the available options) before they select **Request Alignment** (Figure 12).




Figure 13. Request Alignment pop-up showing single discipline available.

- For those Training Centers or Training Sites with only a single discipline available for alignment, the user need only select **Request Alignment** (Figure 13).




Figure 14. Request Alignment confirmation message.

- Selecting the **Request Alignment** button, for both pop-up types, will result in a confirmation message appearing on the **Training Center/Training Site Search Result** page that says, “**Request sent successfully**” (Figure 14).
